The Deutscher Club of Clark was established in 1935 by a local group of German immigrants who shared a common heritage, and wanted to see a center where that heritage would be preserved and honored in their new homeland. We are the largest German/American club in New Jersey, and the second largest in the United States.

Although most of our members are of German ancestry, club membership is open to anyone. All of our members share an interest in German ideals: history, language, culture, food, and music. Members also share their interests in a wide range of general activities supported by the club including: singing - many of our members are actively involved in choirs that perform in this country and abroad; a ski club; various hobby groups such as the "railroaders", who enjoy all things connected to trains; German language classes; outreach activities to local schools to promote awareness of German culture and language; participation in the annual Steuben Day Parade in New York City; club sponsored trips; German movies and much more.
